- The abstract should be up to a maximum of 250 words.
- It should be structured as follows:
 - Title of the workshop
 - List the collaborators or collaborating groups and affiliations
 - Describe the goal of the workshop
 - Describe the methods to be used
 - Describe the expected results
 - Please note that workshops are 1.5 hours long

Submission for Debates

Debates enable discussion of complex and controversial subjects. We invite you to suggest subjects for debate or choose from our debates list. For each subject there will be a speaker for pros and cons.

- Abstracts should be structured as follows:
 - The abstract should be up to a maximum of 250 words.
 - The subject of debate you wish to participate in
 - Your stand (Pro/con)
 - List of arguments regarding it including references
 - Your personal and professional experience that is relevant to the subject
 - Your conclusions

Submission for Oral presentations or Posters (research/project/case report)

- The abstract should be up to a maximum of 250 words.
- It should be structured as follows:
 - Title
 - Authors and affiliation
 - Background
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions

- Poster authors will be asked to participate in a guided walking poster tour
